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

Immunocytochemistry/ Immunofluorescence - Alexa Fluor® 488 Anti-CDK1 antibody [A17] (ab203852) ab203852 staining CDK1 in HeLa cells. The cells were fixed with 4% formaldehyde (10 min), permeabilized with 0.1% Triton X-100 for 5 minutes and then blocked with 1% BSA/10% normal goat serum/0.3M glycine in 0.1% PBS-Tween for 1h. The cells were then incubated overnight at +4°C with ab203852 at a 1/100 dilution (shown in green) and **ab202272**, Rabbit monoclonal to alpha Tubulin (Alexa Fluor<sup>®</sup> 594), at a 1/250 dilution (shown in red). Nuclear DNA was labelled with DAPI (shown in blue).

Image was taken with a confocal microscope (Leica-Microsystems, TCS SP8).

This product also gave a positive signal under the same testing conditions in HeLa cells fixed with 100% methanol (5 min)
