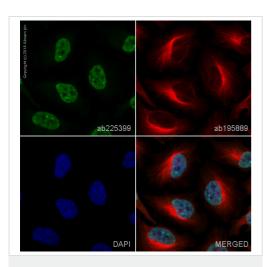

Immunocytochemistry/ Immunofluorescence - Alexa Fluor® 488 Anti-USP22 antibody [EPR18945] (ab225399) ab225399 staining USP22 in HeLa cells. The cells were fixed with 4% formaldehyde (10 min), permeabilized with 0.1% Triton X-100 for 5 minutes and then blocked with 1% BSA/10% normal goat serum/0.3M glycine in 0.1% PBS-Tween for 1h. The cells were then incubated overnight at +4°C with ab225399 at 1/100 dilution (shown in green) and <a href="mailto:ab195889">ab195889</a>, Mouse monoclonal to alpha Tubulin (Alexa Fluor® 594), at 1/250 dilution (shown in red). Nuclear DNA was labelled with DAPI (shown in blue).
